

### IBPS RRB Clerk Notification 2024

On June 7, 2024, IBPS released an official hiring notification for all positions such as Office Assistant (Multipurpose) and Officer Scale I, II, and III. It seeks to promote rural development, enhance the infrastructure supporting rural banking, and increase community access to banking services. Indian citizens are encouraged to apply online for a number of roles at IBPS, including that of Clerk (office assistant). In all, 5800 Office Assistant positions are vacant. Also, the time period of the application process is from 7th June 2024 to 27th June 2024.







The examination evaluates the abilities and knowledge of applicants in a number of domains, such as general awareness, reasoning, computer knowledge, quantitative aptitude, and English. There are mainly two stages to the IBPS RRB Clerk Exam: the preliminary exam and the main exam. #### **Nationality**

You must be any one of the following:

- · A citizen of India
- · A citizen of Nepal
- · A citizen of Bhutan
- A Tibetan Refugee who came over to India before 1st January 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India
- A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.







### Age

Thereafter, knowing the age limit is also crucial.

• You must be between the age limit of 18 years and 28 years.

#### **Educational Qualification**

Lastly, the educational qualifications are as follows:

• You must hold a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or an equivalent qualification.
