



## IBPS RRB Notification 2024

As mentioned above, the IBPS RRB 2024 notification was released on 7th June 2024, highlighting the IBPS RRB Exam Date 2024. Moreover, the time period of the application process is from 7th June 2024 to 27th June 2024. The IBPS RRB examination is a great opportunity for candidates looking to make career in the flourishing field of banking. The Institute of Banking Personnel Selection (IBPS) aims to hire people for different positions in regional rural banks across India. It helps identify candidates for roles like Officer Scale I, II, and III, as well as Office Assistant (Multipurpose). Moreover, it aims to improve rural banking infrastructure, foster rural development, and make banking services more accessible to communities.







Now that we have learnt about the IBPS RRB Exam Date 2024 along with notification release, let us now move further to the eligibility criteria.

# **IBPS RRB Eligibility 2024**

Another important piece of information after learning about the IBPS RRB Exam Date 2024 is the IBPS RRB Eligibility. Hence, the eligibility criteria for IBPS RRB 2024 is as follows:

## **Nationality**

The candidate must be:

- · A citizen of India
- · A citizen of Nepal
- · A citizen of Bhutan
- A Tibetan Refugee who came over to India before 1st January 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India
- A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.

## Age

Thereafter, the age limit for candidates varies according to the post they are applying for.

- For the post of Office Assistants (Multipurpose), the age limit is between 18 years and 28 years.
- For the post of Officer Scale- I (Assistant Manager), the age limit is between 18 years and 30 years.
- For the post of Officer Scale- II (Manager), the age limit is between 21 years and 32 years.
- For the post of Officer Scale- III (Senior Manager), the age limit is between 21 years and 40 years.

## **Educational Qualification**

Lastly, the educational qualifications for the IBPS RRB Exam 2024 are as follows:

- Office Assistant: A bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or an equivalent qualification is required.
- Officer Scale I (Assistant Manager): A bachelor's degree in any field is necessary.
- Officer Scale II General Banking Officer (Manager): A bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or its equivalent, with at least 50% marks in aggregate.
- · Officer Scale II Specialist Officers (Manager):
  - **Information Technology Officer**: A degree in any field with at least 50% marks in Electronics, Communication, Computer Science, Information Technology, Law, etc.
  - Chartered Accountant: Certified Associate (CA) from the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.
  - Law Officer: A degree in Law from a recognized university or its equivalent with at least 50% marks in aggregate.
  - Marketing Officer: Chartered Accountant or MBA in Finance from a recognized university/institution.
  - Agricultural Officer: A bachelor's degree in Agriculture, Horticulture, Dairy, Animal Husbandry, Forestry,
    Veterinary Science, Agricultural Engineering, or Pisciculture from a recognized university or its equivalent with at least 50% marks in aggregate.
- Officer Scale III (Senior Manager): A degree in any field with a minimum of 50% marks.

## IBPS RRB Exam Pattern 2024

## **Preliminary Examination**

The preliminary examination for the IBPS RRB 2024 is an objective-type examination and carries two tests of 40 marks each amounting to a total of 80 marks. However, the name of the tests differ according to the post:

## Office Assistant (Multipurpose)

There are two tests both of which comprise 40 questions of one marks each.

- Reasoning 40 marks
- Numerical Ability 40 marks

#### Officer Scale-I

There are two exams, each consisting of 40 questions worth one mark each.

- · Reasoning 40 marks
- Quantitative Aptitude 40 marks

Now, let us discuss the exam pattern for the main examination.

## **Main Examination**

Just like the preliminary examination, the main examination for IBPS RRB 2024 is an objective-type examination and carries 100 marks. However, the tests under the main examination differ according to the the post the candidate has applied for. Hence, let us take a look at the tests that come under various posts.

### Office assistant (Multipurpose)

The exam consists of five exams with 40 questions each.







- Reasoning 50 Marks
- · Computer Knowledge 20 Marks
- General Awareness 40 marks
- English Language/Hindi Language 40 marks
- · Numerical Ability 50 Marks

### Officer Scale-I

The exam includes five sections, each containing 40 questions.

- Reasoning 50 Marks
- Computer Knowledge 20 Marks
- · General Awareness 40 marks
- English Language/Hindi Language 40 marks
- · Quantitative Aptitude 50 Marks
