

The Institute of Banking Personnel Selection (IBPS) released the IBPS SO 2024 Notification on August 1, 2024, along with the application form on their website. You can complete the registration process for IBPS SO 2024 from August 1, 2024, to August 21, 2024.








The Institute of Banking Personnel Selection (IBPS) has announced a total of 896 vacancies for Specialist Officer positions. Specifically, there are 346 openings for Agricultural Field Officers (AFO), 205 for Marketing Officers, 125 for Law Officers, 170 for IT Officers, 25 for HR/Personnel Officers, and 25 for Rajbhasa Specialist Officers.

IBPS SO 2024 Eligibility

You must read the eligibility criteria properly to know whether you are eligible for the exam. There are three parameters (nationality, age limit, and educational qualification) that you need to fulfill to be eligible for IBPS SO Recruitment 2024.

Nationality

You must be either:

- a citizen of India or
- · a subject of Nepal or
- · a subject of Bhutan or
- a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before January 1, 1962, intending to permanently settle in India or
- a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, the East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, and Vietnam, intending to permanently settle in India.

Age Limit

You must be between the ages of 20 and 30. A candidate must have been born not earlier than 02.08.1994 and not later than 01.08.2004 (both dates inclusive). Furthermore, there are a few relaxations to the upper age limit for specific categories.

Educational Qualification

IBPS SO recruits candidates for various posts like I.T. Officer, Agricultural Field Officer, Rajbhasha Adhikari, Law Officer, HR/Personnel Officer, Marketing Officer, etc. To fit into the IBPS SO Eligibility Criteria 2024, you need to fulfill these qualifications.

- **Total Question:** 60 questions for the post of Law Officer, IT Officer, Agriculture Field Officer, HR/Personnel Officer and Marketing Officer and 47 questions for the post of Rajbhasha Adhikari.
- **Duration:** 45 minutes for the post of Law Officer, IT Officer, Agriculture Field Officer, HR/Personnel Officer and Marketing Officer and 60 minutes for Rajbhasha Adhikari.

- IT Officer, Agriculture Field Officer, HR/Personnel Officer and Marketing Officer: Reasoning, English Language and Quantitative Aptitude.

Main Examination

- Law Officer, IT Officer, Agriculture Field Officer, HR/Personnel Officer and Marketing Officer: Professional Knowledge
- · Rajbhasha Adhikari: Professional Knowledge (Objective) and Professional Knowledge (Descriptive).
