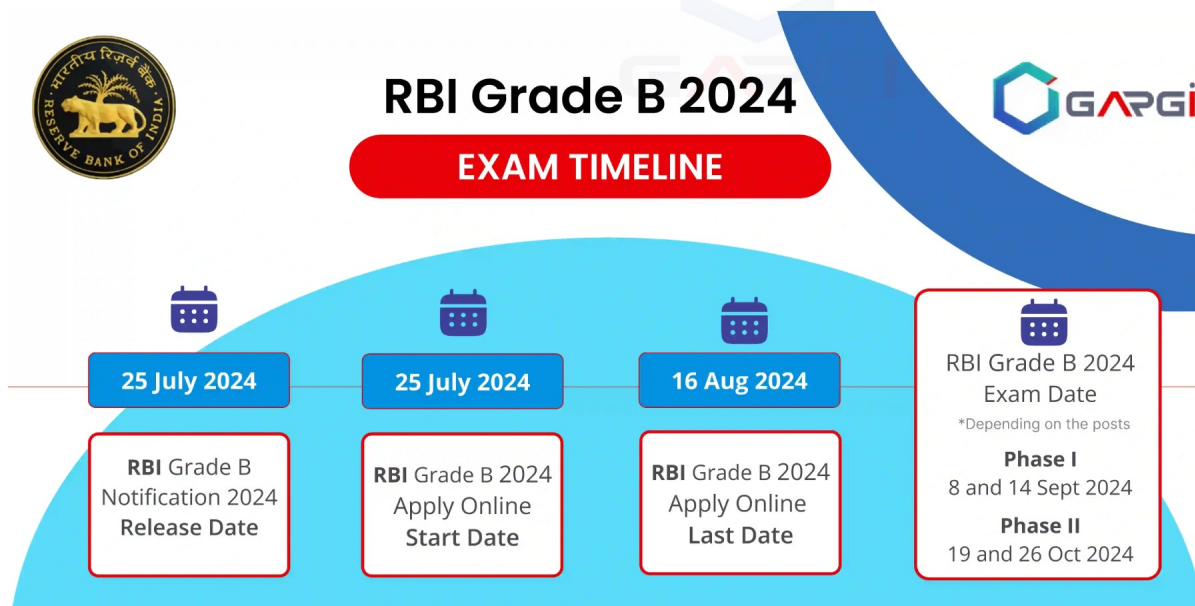

RBI Grade B Eligibility 2024

Ensure you meet the nationality requirements, fit within the specified age range, and hold the required qualifications. Nationality:

Candidates must meet one of the following criteria:

- Be a citizen of India, or
- A subject of Nepal, or
- A subject of Bhutan, or
- A Tibetan refugee who entered India before January 1, 1962, intending to settle permanently, or
- A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, or Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.

Note: Candidates from the last four categories must obtain an eligibility certificate from the Government of India.

Age Limit (As of 01.07.2024):

According to the RBI Grade B Notification 2024, the age criteria for the RBI Grade B Exam are as follows:

- Minimum age: 21 years
- Maximum age: 30 years

Candidates must have been born between July 02, 1994, and July 01, 2003. Age relaxation is provided as per government rules for candidates from reserved categories to ensure equal opportunities.

Educational Qualification (As of 01.07.2024):

The required educational qualifications for the RBI Grade B Exam 2024 are as follows:

For Officer in Grade B (DR) - General:

- Graduation in any discipline or equivalent technical/professional qualification with a minimum of 60% marks (50% for SC/ST/PwBD candidates), or
- Post-graduation in any discipline or equivalent technical/professional qualification with a minimum of 55% marks (pass marks for SC/ST/PwBD candidates).

For Officer in Grade B (DR) - DSIM:

- A Master's Degree in Economics or related fields where "Economics" is the main subject (e.g., MA/MSc in Quantitative Economics, Financial Economics, Agricultural Economics, etc.), or
- A Master's Degree in Finance or related fields with "Finance" as the main focus (e.g., MA/MSc in Quantitative Finance, Business Finance, International Finance, etc.), with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate.

For Officer in Grade B (DR) - DEPR:

- A Master's Degree in Statistics, Econometrics, or a related field with at least 55% marks, or
- A Master's Degree in Mathematics with 55% marks and a one-year postgraduate diploma in Statistics, or
- A Master's in Data Science, AI, or Big Data Analytics with 55% marks, or
- A four-year Bachelor's Degree in Data Science/AI/ML/Big Data Analytics with 60% marks, or
- A two-year Post Graduate Diploma in Business Analytics (PGDBA) with 55% marks.

RBI Grade B Exam Pattern 2024

- Duration: 120 minutes
