Nationality:

To be eligible for the SBI Clerk Exam 2025, candidates must be:

- An Indian Citizen
- A Subject of Nepal or Bhutan
- A Tibetan Refugee who arrived in India before January 1, 1962, with the intention of permanent settlement
- A Person of Indian Origin (PIO) who migrated from Burma, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Vietnam, or East African countries such as Zaire, Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, Ethiopia, or Malawi, with the intention of permanent settlement in India

Candidates from categories 2, 3, and 4 must have a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India.

Age:

The age limits for the exam are as follows:

- The minimum age to apply for the SBI Clerk 2025 is 20 years
- The maximum age is 28 years

Educational Qualification:

Candidates must possess a bachelor's degree to be eligible for this position. Other acceptable qualifications include:

- Candidates must have completed (or be in the process of completing) an Integrated Dual Degree (IDD) before the cut-off date, which will be determined by SBI.
