8.	Trained Apprentices of SBI	SC/ST - 6 years, OBC - 4 years, GEN/ EWS - 1 year, PwBD (SC/ST) - 16 years, PwBD (OBC) - 14 years, PwBD (Gen/EWS) - 11 years
