- Additionally, the English Language (Letter Writing & Essay) section of the Main examination will feature 2 descriptive questions, worth 25 marks. This test will be conducted over a duration of 30 minutes.

## Nationality

To be eligible, you must be:

- An Indian citizen, or
- A subject of Nepal or Bhutan, or
- A Tibetan refugee who permanently settled in India before January 1, 1962, or
- A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries such as Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.

It is important to note that if you belong to the last three above-mentioned categories then you must possess a certificate of eligibility issued by the government of India.

## Educational Qualifications (As on 21.08.2024)

- Have a Graduation degree from a recognized University or an equivalent qualification recognized by the Central Government.
- Possess a valid mark sheet or Degree Certificate on the day of registration and indicate your graduation marks percentage online.

## Age Limit (As on 01.08.2024)



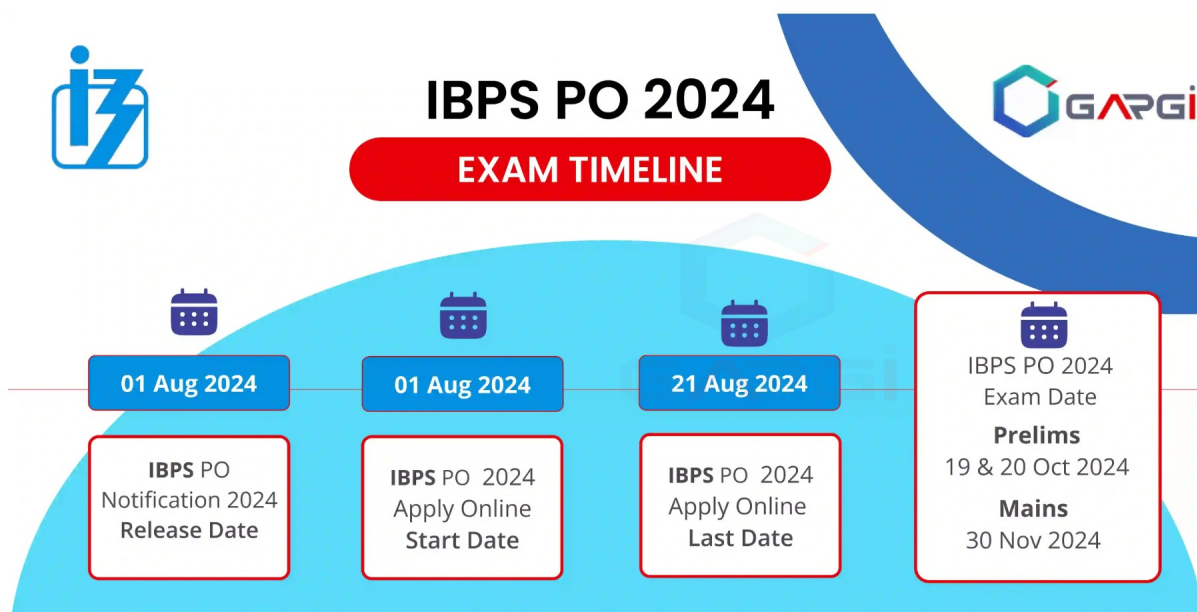

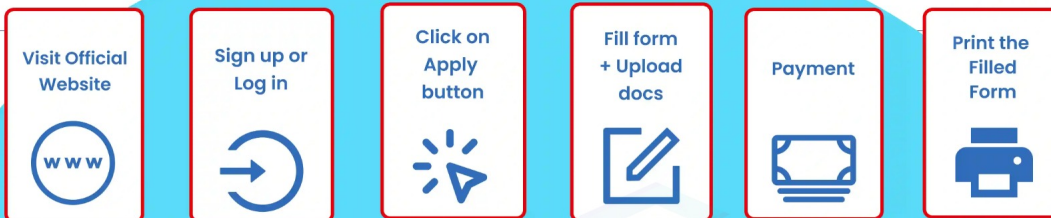
