







First up is the **Preliminary Exam**. This is the initial screening round, designed to shortlist candidates for the next stage. If you clear this hurdle, you'll advance to the **Mains Exam**, a more comprehensive assessment of your banking aptitude. Those who excel in the Mains Exam will be invited to the final stage i.e., the **Interview round**. This is your chance to showcase your personality, communication skills, and overall suitability for a banking career. # **IBPS PO Selection Process 2024 - Preliminary Examination**









Your first challenge in the IBPS PO Selection Process 2024 is the Preliminary Exam. It's an online test filled with objective-type questions. To move on to the next stage, you'll need to clear both the sectional and overall cut-offs. Remember, the exam is worth 100 marks, divided into English, Reasoning, and Quantitative Aptitude sections. But watch out! There's a negative marking of 1/4 of the assigned mark for each wrong answer. Below is a snippet from the

Now that you've equipped yourself with the details about the preliminary exam, let us introduce you to yet another stage of the IBPS PO Selection Process 2024, that is, the Mains examination.

# **IBPS PO Selection Process 2024 - Mains Examination**

Next up after the Preliminary Examination is the Mains Examination, and only those who score well enough to meet the minimum IBPS PO cut-offs for their category will make it to this stage. Like the Prelims, it's an online exam with a penalty of 1/4 of the assigned mark for incorrect answers. But here's the twist: the Mains Exam includes objective and descriptive questions, spread across five sections with specific time limits for each. With a total of 225 marks on the line, you'll need to be well-prepared. Here's a snippet from the official notification for your understanding:

Now that you've got a hold of the Mains exam of the IBPS PO Selection Process 2024, next up are details that you need to know about the final step of the IBPS PO Selection Process 2024, that is, the Interview round.

# IBPS PO Selection Process 2024 - Interview

To make it to the interview stage, you'll need to meet the minimum cut-off scores for both sectional and overall test in the Mains Examination. Important things to know about the interview round are:

- Both clearing Prelims and Mains is mandatory to be eligible.
- The interview carries 100 marks.
- Your Mains score and interview score will be combined in an 80:20 ratio to create the final merit list.
- You'll need a minimum of 40% marks (35% for SC/ST/OBC/PWBD) to make the final cut.

Let us move forward and shed some light on all the documents required to apply for the IBPS PO Exam 2024.

# **IBPS PO Selection Process 2024 - Documents Required**

To successfully apply for the IBPS PO exam, you'll need to have the following documents ready:







- Scanned photograph: Ensure it meets the specified size and format requirements.
- Scanned signature: Again, adhere to the given specifications.
- Left thumb impression: This is typically required for verification purposes.
- Handwritten declaration: You'll need to draft this as per the provided format.
- Graduation mark-sheet: This document is essential to prove your educational qualification.
- Valid email ID and contact number: These are crucial for communication and updates.

# **Nationality**

To be eligible, you must be:

- · An Indian citizen, or
- · A subject of Nepal or Bhutan, or
- · A Tibetan refugee who permanently settled in India before January 1, 1962, or
- A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries such as Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.



It is important to note that if you belong to the last three above-mentioned categories then you must possess a certificate of eligibility issued by the government of India.

### **Educational Qualifications (As on 21.08.2024)**

- Have a Graduation degree from a recognized University or an equivalent qualification recognized by the Central Government.
- Possess a valid mark sheet or Degree Certificate on the day of registration and indicate your graduation marks percentage online.

# Age Limit (As on 01.08.2024)

• You must be between 20 and 30 years old to be eligible for the IBPS PO exam.


