## IBPS RRB Exam Pattern 2024 - Officer Scale I

The Officer Scale I exam has two parts: a preliminary round (prelims) and a final round (mains). But for Officer Scales II and III, there's just one exam. If you do well on the Officer Scale I mains exam (or the single exam for Officer Scales II and III), you'll be invited to an interview - that's the final step to get the job! And by the way, the entire exam will be online with multiple choice questions, so you can answer on your computer.

- The mains exam delves deeper into each subject compared to the prelims.
- Some sections may include descriptive questions, so hone your writing skills.

## IBPS RRB Exam Pattern 2024 - Office Assistant

First up, the **Preliminary Stage**. Imagine it as a quick quiz - you'll answer questions on your computer for just 45 minutes. There are two subjects, each with 40 questions, so it's all about speed and accuracy. Feeling nervous? Don't worry, we'll help you conquer this round in no time! Now, if you ace the prelims, you'll move on to the **Mains Stage**. This is a bigger exam, also on the computer, but this time you'll have 2 hours to answer 200 questions across five subjects. Each question is worth 1 mark, so stay focused and show them what you've got!

## Preliminary Examination:-

- **Reasoning:** This section challenges your thinking and problem-solving skills. Expect questions on puzzles, arrangements, coding-decoding, and more.
- **Numerical Ability:** Time to dust off your math skills! You'll face questions on calculations, number properties, data interpretation, and other numerical concepts.

- **General Awareness:** Stay informed! This section tests your knowledge of current affairs, banking, economics, and India's social and political landscape.
- **English Language/Hindi Language:** Choose your weapon! This test assesses your writing, comprehension, and grammar skills in either English or Hindi.
- **Numerical Ability:** Sharper and deeper than the prelims, this test will assess your advanced numerical abilities.

## IBPS RRB Exam Pattern 2024 - Eligibility Criteria

The Institute of Banking Personnel (IBPS) has released the IBPS RRB Recruitment Notification 2024 for the RRB Office Assistant (Multipurpose) post along with the official notification. Candidates appearing for the IBPS RRB Office Assistant recruitment process must go through the IBPS Office Assistant Eligibility Criteria to know the requirement that they need to fulfil for the recruitment process.

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## IBPS RRB Notification

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA 2024

Following are the Eligibility Criteria for IBPS RRB



#### Nationality

A citizen of India,  
a subject of Nepal or,  
a subject of Bhutan or  
a Tibetan Refugee,.....



#### Education

\*as on 27.06.2024

Bachelors Degree or equiv.

For both PO and Clerk



#### Age Limit

\*as on 01.06.2024

PO - Between 18 to 30 years  
\*Officer Scale 1

Clerk - Between 18 to 28  
years

## Nationality

Firstly, to be eligible for the IBPS RRB Exam 2024, a candidate must fall under one of the following categories:

- a Citizen of India or
- a subject of Nepal or
- a subject of Bhutan or
- a Tibetan Refugee who came over to India before January 1, 1962, to permanently settle in India.
- a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam intending to permanently settle in India.

Remember that if you belong to any of the last four categories, then you must have a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India.

## Age Limit (As on 01.06.2024)

Secondly, the age criteria for the IBPS RRB Exam 2024 as per the IBPS RRB Notification 2024 are as follows:

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1. **For Office Assistant:** You must fall between the ages of 18 to 28 years.
2. **For Officer Scale I (Assistant Manager):** You should be above 18 years and below 30 years and should not have been born earlier than 03.06.1994 and later than 31.05.2006 (both dates inclusive).
3. **For Officer Scale II (Manager):** You should be above 21 years and below 32 years and should not have been born earlier than 03.06.1992 and later than 31.05.2003 (both dates inclusive).
4. **For Officer Scale III (Senior Manager):** You should be above 21 years and below 40 years and should not have been born earlier than 03.06.1984 and later than 31.05.2003 (both dates inclusive).

## Educational Qualification (As on 27.06.2024)

Lastly, the educational qualification for IBPS RRB Exam 2024 is as follows:

- **Office Assistant:** You must complete a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or possess an equivalent qualification.
- **Officer Scale I (Assistant Manager):** You must hold a bachelor's degree in any field.
- **Officer Scale II General Banking Officer (Manager):** A Bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized University or its equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate is required.
- **Officer Scale II Specialist Officers (Manager):**
  - **For Information Technology Officer post,** you must hold a degree in any field with a minimum of 50% in Electronics, Communication, Computer Science, Information Technology, Law etc.
  - **For Chartered Accountant post,** you are required to have a Certified Associate (CA) from the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.
  - **For Law Officer post,** you are required to have a degree from a recognised University in Law or its equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate.
  - **For Marketing Officer post,** a Chartered Accountant or MBA in Finance from a recognized university/ institution is required.
  - **For Agricultural Officer post,** a bachelor's degree in Agriculture/ Horticulture/ Dairy/ Animal Husbandry/ Forestry/ Veterinary Science/ Agricultural Engineering/ Pisciculture from a recognized university or its equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate is necessary.
- **Officer Scale III (Senior Manager):** You must hold a degree in any field with a minimum grade point average of 50%.

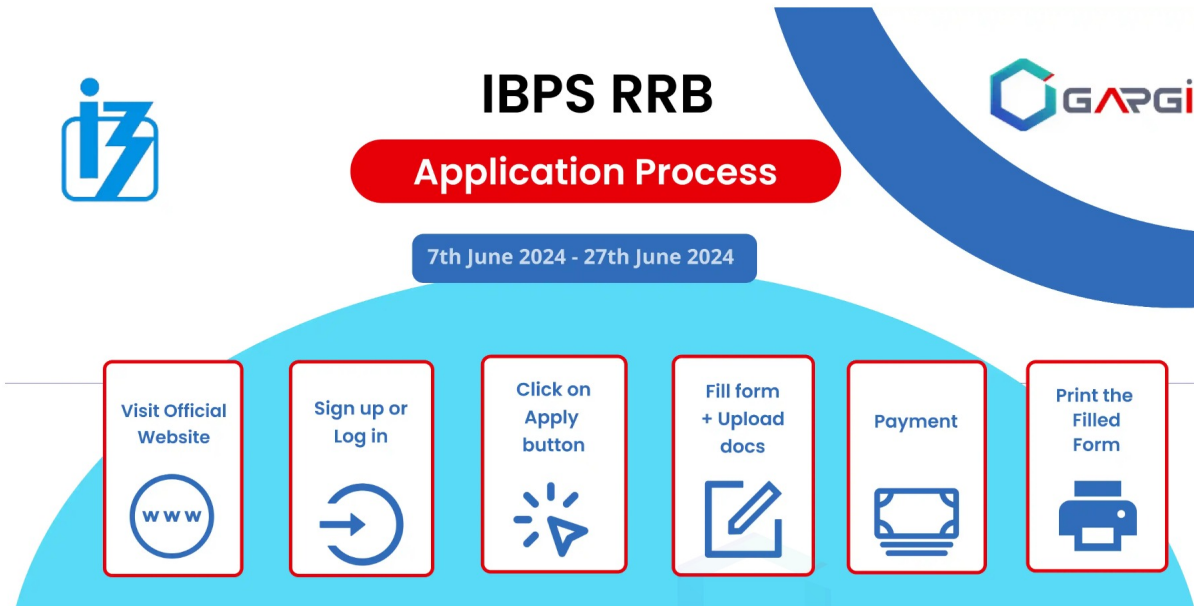

The application process for the IBPS RRB Office Assistant 2024 started on June 7, 2024. The candidates must be aware of the process to fill out the application process. Go through the following process, which describes filling out the IBPS RRB Officer Assistant application form.

- To start the application process, visit the official IBPS website and look for the registration link. Create an account by providing your basic personal information, including your name, email address, and phone number. This initial registration is necessary to access the application form.
- Once registered, find and click on the relevant links to apply for the Office Assistant position under the IBPS RRB recruitment section. This will direct you to the application form specifically designed for the Office Assistant recruitment process.
- Fill in your basic details such as name, date of birth, and address in the application form. Additionally, upload a scanned photograph and signature in the specified format and size as mentioned in the official RRB notification. Ensure the documents meet the size and clarity requirements to avoid rejection.
- Complete the application form by entering your educational qualifications, professional experience, and any other required details. This information helps verify your eligibility for the Office Assistant position.
- Choose your preferred Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) in order of preference. Carefully consider the location and working conditions of each bank to make informed decisions about where you would like to work if selected. This step is crucial as it determines your placement within the RRB network.
