



Age Limit:

- You must be between 20 and 28 years old.
- There are age relaxation provisions for certain categories, allowing some candidates to apply even if they exceed this age range.

Educational Qualifications:

You must have a bachelor's degree in any discipline with at least 50% marks. If you belong to the SC/ST/PwBD category, passing marks are sufficient. Additionally, you should be proficient in word processing on a PC.
