

SBI Clerk 2025 Exam Pattern - Mains

SBI Clerk 2025 Exam Pattern - Local Language Test

- Candidates who produce 10th or 12th standard mark sheet/certificate showing proficiency in the specified local language will not need to take the language test.
- Candidates who do not have this proof will undergo a specified local language test after provisional selection but before joining.
- Candidates failing the language test will not be offered the appointment.
- · Candidates not proficient in the specified local language will be disqualified.
- Marks obtained in the Preliminary Examination (Phase-I) will not be considered for selection.
- Only the aggregate marks from the Main Examination (Phase-II) will be used to prepare the final merit list.
- Provisional selection is based on performance in the Main Examination (Phase-II).

SBI Clerk 2025 Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the SBI Clerk 2025, a candidate must fall under one of the following categories:

Age Limit

• Not below 20 years and not above 28 years as on 01.04.2024, i.e. candidates must have been born not earlier than 02.04.1996 and not later than 01.04.2004 (both days inclusive).

Qualification

- Graduation in any discipline from a recognized university or an equivalent qualification recognized by the Central Government.
- Candidates with an Integrated Dual Degree (IDD) certificate must ensure the date of passing is on or before **31.12.2024**.
- Candidates in their final year/semester may apply provisionally, but they must provide proof of graduation completion on or before **31.12.2024** if selected.

Remember that if you belong to any of the last four categories, then you must have a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India.
