

SBI Clerk Exam Pattern 2024 - Prelims

The first stage of the SBI Clerk exam is the preliminary exam, which consists of 100 objective-type questions for 100 marks and will be conducted online.

- The preliminary stage has 3 sections in total, and the duration of the exam would be 1 hour.
- · You'll face challenges in two sections: Reasoning Ability and Numerical Ability.
- Prepare yourself for answering multiple-choice questions that will evaluate your numerical and mental abilities.
- There will be negative marks for wrong answers. 1/4th of the mark assigned for the question will be deducted for each wrong answer.

SBI Clerk Exam Pattern 2024 - Mains

The second stage of the SBI Clerk exam is the mains exam, which consists of objective-type questions for 200 marks and will be conducted online.

- This stage is more comprehensive. So, buckle up for four sections in the mains exam: **General/Financial Awareness, General English, Quantitative Aptitude**, **Reasoning Ability & Computer Aptitude**.
- Reasoning Ability & Computer Aptitude hold more weightage so you have to practice more in this section.
- There will be negative marks for wrong answers. 1/4th of the mark assigned for the question will be deducted for each wrong answer.

Moreover, the Mains exam consists of 4 subjects.









- 1. General/Financial Awareness
- 2. General English
- 3. Quantitative Aptitude
- 4. Reasoning Ability and Computer Aptitude

SBI Clerk 2024 - Local Language Test

Language tests will not be administered to candidates who qualify for selection and show proof of studying the specified opted local language in their 10th or 12th grade mark sheets. In the case of others (qualified for selection), a specified opted local language test will be conducted after provisional selection but before joining. Candidates not found proficient in the specified opted local language would be disqualified.

SBI Clerk Exam Pattern 2024 Syllabus

The SBI Clerk syllabus is comprehensive, covering crucial topics with maximum weightage, along with other relevant details. To begin with, there are two phases in the SBI Clerk exam: the preliminary round (prelims) and the final round (mains). Therefore, the SBI Clerk's main examination is more difficult, and success requires more practice.

Preliminary Exam

- English language Reading Comprehension and the Cloze Test are some important topics in this section.
- Numerical Ability This holds more weighage and Simplification/Approximation is the topic out of which questions
 are frequently asked.
- **Reasoning Ability** This holds the same weight as numerical ability. Puzzle And Seating Arrangement questions need to be practiced more.





Mains Exam

- General English Similar to the prelims, but potentially more complex.
- Quantitative Aptitude Sharper and deeper than the prelims, arithmetic needs to be practiced more.
- Reasoning Ability & Computer Aptitude Get ready for questions on basic computer operations and MS Office applications.
- **General/Financial Awareness** Stay informed! This section tests your knowledge of current affairs, banking, economics, and financial markets.

You can practice questions daily on different subjects and plan your studies effectively.

SBI Clerk Exam Pattern 2024 - Eligibility Criteria

The State Bank of India (SBI) will release the SBI Clerk Recruitment Notification 2024 for the Junior Associate (Customer Support & Sales) post along with the official notification. Firstly, to be eligible for the SBI Clerk Exam 2024, a candidate must fall under one of the following categories:

- · a Citizen of India or
- · a subject of Nepal or
- · a subject of Bhutan or
- a Tibetan Refugee who came over to India before January 1, 1962, to permanently settle in India.
- a person of Indian origin migrated from Uganda, Burma, Pakistan, Zambia, the United Republic of Tanzania, Malawi, Sri Lanka, East African Countries of Kenya, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam to settle in India.

Remember that if you belong to any of the last four categories, then you must have a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India.

Age Limit

Secondly, the age criteria for the SBI Clerk Exam as per the notification are as follows:

- Not below 20 years and not above 28 years.
- The relaxation of the Upper age limit for SC/ST is 5 years; for OBC, it is 3 years.

Educational Qualification

Lastly, the educational qualification for the SBI Clerk Exam 2024 is as follows:

- You must be a graduate in any discipline from a recognized university or have any equivalent qualification recognized as such by Central Government.
- If you are in the final year or semester of your graduation, you may also apply provisionally, subject to the condition that, if provisionally selected, you will have to produce proof of having passed the graduation examination.
