SBI PO Exam Pattern 2024 - Preliminary Exam

The SBI PO Exam's first round is the Preliminary Exam. The exam pattern for the prelims exam is as follows:





- It consists of 3 sections, each to be completed in 20 minutes.
- The total marks for the Prelims Exam are 100, with a duration of 1 hour.
- Candidates earn 1 mark for every correct answer.
- There is a penalty of 1/4 of the assigned marks for every incorrect answer.

Those who qualify this preliminary examination, become eligible to appear in the mains examination. So, let us now acquaint you with the SBI PO exam pattern 2024 for the mains examination in the next segment.

SBI PO Exam Pattern 2024 - Mains Exam

The SBI PO Exam's second round is the Mains exam. The exam pattern for the mains exam is provided below:

- The Main Examination will be conducted online, consisting of Objective Tests for 200 marks and Descriptive Tests for 50 marks.
- The exam includes four sections and a descriptive section.
- The Descriptive Test will be administered immediately after the Objective Test, with candidates typing their answers on the computer.
- There will be a penalty for incorrect answers; 1/4th of the marks assigned to each incorrect question will be deducted.
- No penalty will be applied for questions left blank.

(i) Objective Test: The duration of objective test is 3 hours, and it consists of 4 Sections of total 200 marks. There will be separate timing for every section.

- Age Limit: You must be between 21 and 30 years old as on the date specified in the notification. However, there are some age relaxations too.
- Educational Qualification: cYou must hold a graduate degree in any discipline from a recognized university or an equivalent qualification recognized by the Central Government. If you are a final year/semester student, you can apply provisionally but must provide proof of graduation at the interview. Moreover, if you are someone with an Integrated Dual Degree (IDD) certificate, you must ensure that the date of passing the IDD aligns with the specified date in the notification.

- Log in and upload your photo and signature in the format specified by the State Bank of India for SBI PO 2024.
- · Upload your documents in the required format.
- Submit the application form and take a printout for reference.

SBI PO Application Fee

The category-wise fee structure for the SBI PO 2024 online application is as follows. The application fee/intimation charges once paid will NOT be refunded under any circumstances nor can they be held in reserve for any other examination or selection. The application fee is Nil for SC/ST/PWD category candidates and Rs. 750/- for General and other categories of candidates. The fee must be paid online.
