### Nationality:

To be eligible for the IBPS Clerk exam, you must meet the following nationality requirements:

- Indian citizen
- Subject of Bhutan or Nepal
- Tibetan refugee who migrated to India before 1st January 1962 for permanent settlement
- A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Burma, Uganda, Kenya, Tanzania, Malawi, Zambia, Ethiopia, Zaire, or Vietnam with the intention of permanent settlement in India

Note: Candidates in categories other than Indian citizenship must possess an eligibility certificate issued by the Indian government.

### Age Limit (As on 01.07.2024):

The age limits for the general category in IBPS Clerk recruitment are as follows:

- Minimum age: 20 years (mandatory age limit to be eligible)
- Maximum age: 28 years (applicant's age should not exceed this limit)

### Educational Qualification (As on 21.07.2024):

If you are applying for the IBPS Clerk position, then, you must:

- Possess a graduate degree in any discipline from a University recognized by the Government of India.
- Demonstrate proficiency in computer operations through a diploma course or degree in this field.
- Be proficient in speaking, reading, and writing the language of the state they are applying for.

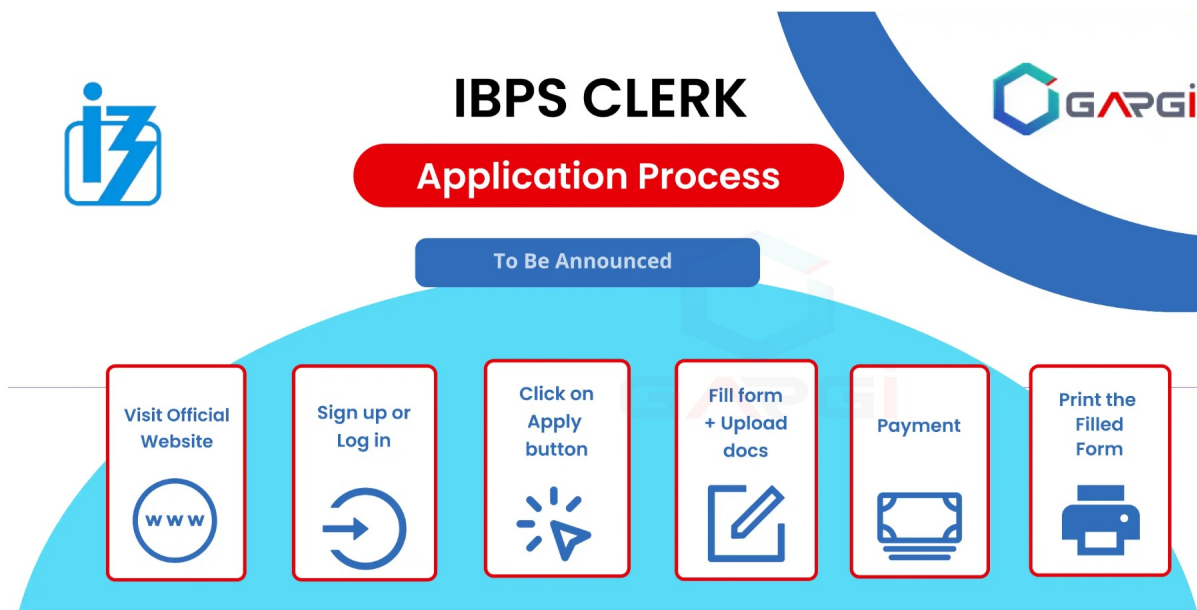

Below is the category-wise fee structure for the IBPS Clerk online application. Once paid, the fee/intimation charges cannot be refunded or reserved for any other examination or selection process. The application fee must be paid online.

There are two stages to the IBPS Clerk exam: Preliminary and Main Examination. These two papers are written exams that are conducted online. The exam is structured as follows:

### Phase-1: IBPS Clerk Preliminary Examination:

IBPS Clerk prelims is an online exam that will assess your aptitude, reasoning, and English. It consists of three sections, each with a 20-minutes time limit. You must clear section-wise cutoffs to advance to the Mains examination. The total marks for this exam is 100, and passing marks vary annually based on exam difficulty levels set by IBPS.

#### a. Preliminary Examination

You must meet the minimum cut-off marks set by IBPS in each of the three tests. IBPS will decide the required number of candidates to be shortlisted in each category based on their specific needs for the Online Main Examination.

### Phase-2: IBPS Clerk Mains Examination:

IBPS Clerk Mains Exam now includes 190 questions to be completed in 160 minutes. The Computer Aptitude and Reasoning Ability sections have been combined, comprising 50 questions to be solved within 45 minutes. Both Preliminary and Mains examination will be conducted in 13 regional languages, as well as in English and Hindi.
