

- A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Burma, Uganda, Kenya, Tanzania, Malawi, Zambia, Ethiopia, Zaire, or Vietnam with the intention of permanent settlement in India

Age Limit (As on 01.07.2024):

The age limits for the general category in IBPS Clerk recruitment are as follows:

- Minimum age: 20 years (mandatory age limit to be eligible)
- Maximum age: 28 years (applicant's age should not exceed this limit)

Educational Qualification:






If you are applying for the IBPS Clerk position, you must:


The fees for various categories are as follows:

Preliminary Examination:





- The IBPS Clerk prelims is an online examination designed to evaluate your aptitude, reasoning, and English skills.
- It comprises three sections, each with a time limit of 20 minutes.
- You must meet the section-wise cutoffs to progress to the Mains examination.
- The total score for this exam is 100, and the passing marks fluctuate each year based on the difficulty levels determined by IBPS.

Mains Examination:

- The IBPS Clerk Mains Exam now consists of 190 questions to be completed in 160 minutes.
- The Computer Aptitude and Reasoning Ability sections have been merged, totaling 50 questions to be answered within 45 minutes.
- Both the Preliminary and Mains examinations will be offered in 13 regional languages, in addition to English and Hindi
