



To be eligible for the IBPS Clerk exam, you must satisfy one of the following nationality criteria:

- · Indian citizen
- · Subject of Bhutan or Nepal
- Tibetan refugee who migrated to India before January 1, 1962, intending to settle permanently
- A person of Indian origin who migrated from Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Burma, Uganda, Kenya, Tanzania, Malawi, Zambia, Ethiopia, Zaire, or Vietnam with the intention of permanent settlement in India

*Note*: Candidates in categories other than Indian citizens must have an eligibility certificate issued by the Indian government.

#### Age Limit (As of 01.07.2024):

For IBPS Clerk recruitment, the age criteria for the general category are:

- Minimum age: 20 years (required to be eligible)
- Maximum age: 28 years (applicants must not exceed this age)

#### Educational Qualification (As of 21.07.2024):

To apply for the IBPS Clerk position, you must:

- Hold a graduate degree in any discipline from a university recognized by the Government of India.
- Have computer proficiency, demonstrated through a diploma or degree in computer operations.
- Be proficient in speaking, reading, and writing the language of the state you are applying for.


