Prepare for Interview

In addition to preparing for the online examination, ensure you are well-prepared for the interview. Practice answering common and situational questions confidently, and rehearse in front of a mirror to boost your confidence. Maintain proper posture, make eye contact, and smile politely during the interview. Additionally, stay updated on current affairs and banking trends.

Design a realistic and structured timetable. Allocate specific time slots for each section and dedicate more time to topics you find challenging. Include regular breaks to maintain focus and avoid burnout. Stick to the schedule to ensure consistency.

Strengthen Your Basics

Focus on building a strong foundation in all subjects. Revise basic concepts in Quantitative Aptitude, Grammar rules in English, and reasoning techniques. Once you're confident with the basics, move on to advanced-level questions.

Stay Healthy and Positive

A healthy mind and body are vital for effective preparation. Maintain a balanced diet, exercise regularly, and get sufficient sleep. Practice stress-relief techniques like meditation or deep breathing to stay calm and focused. Believe in your preparation and maintain a positive attitude throughout the journey.

Learn Shortcuts and Tricks

For Quantitative Aptitude and Reasoning, master shortcuts, formulas, and tricks to solve problems quickly. Practice these methods regularly to enhance your efficiency during the exam.

IBPS PO 2025 Preparation - Exam Pattern

The IBPS PO Recruitment 2025 comprises three stages: the Preliminary Exam, the Mains Exam, and an Interview.

The Preliminary Exam features three sections: English Language, Quantitative Aptitude, and Reasoning Ability. Each section has a specified time limit, and the test includes multiple-choice questions (MCQs). There are 100 questions in total, with a combined time limit of 60 minutes. Each correct answer awards 1 mark, while 0.25 marks are deducted for every incorrect response. Performing well in this stage is essential, as it determines your eligibility for the next phase of the selection process.

The IBPS PO Mains Exam covers the following subjects:

- Reasoning and Computer Aptitude
- General/Economy/Banking Awareness
- English Language
- Data Analysis & Interpretation
- English Language (Letter Writing and Essay)





This stage is more comprehensive and assesses your in-depth knowledge. Each section carries specific weightage. The exam includes a total of 155 objective questions along with 2 descriptive questions on letter writing and essay. The maximum marks for the exam are 200 for the objective section and 25 for the descriptive section. The time allotted is 3 hours for the objective section and an additional 30 minutes for the descriptive section.
