Nationality:

To be eligible for this exam, you should be one of the following:

- A citizen of India, or
- A subject of Nepal, or
- A subject of Bhutan, or
- A Tibetan refugee who came to India before January 1, 1962, to permanently settle in India, or
- A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, or the East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, or Vietnam with the intent to permanently settle in India.

Please note, if you belong to any of the above-mentioned categories other than being a citizen of India, you must present a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India.

To be eligible for the IBPS PO exam 2024, your age should be between 20 and 30 years.

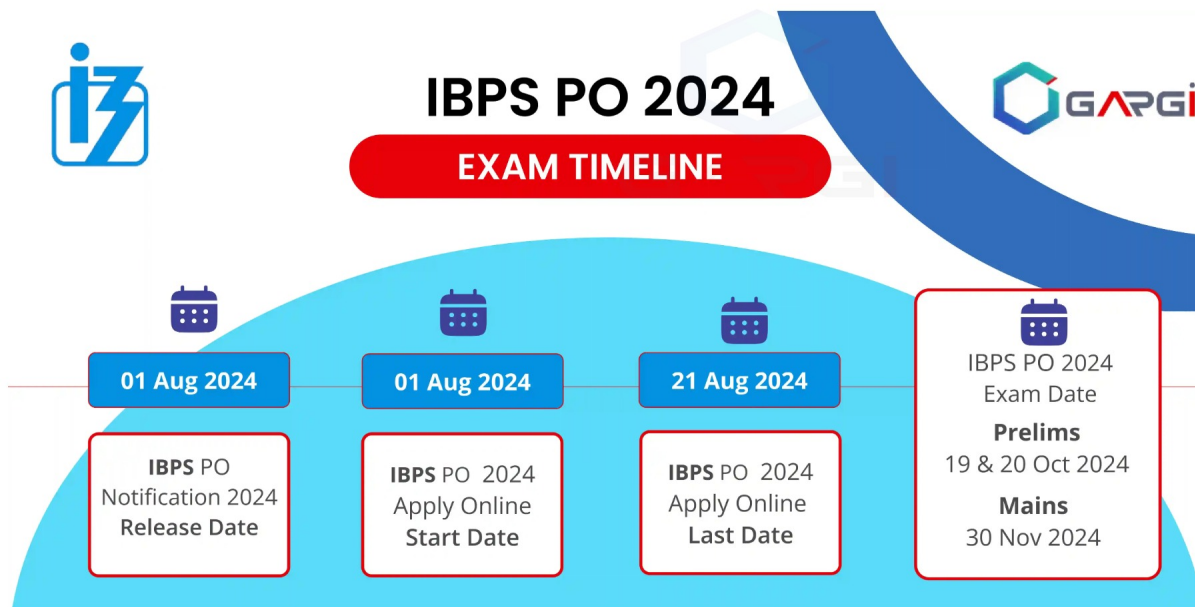
Educational Qualification

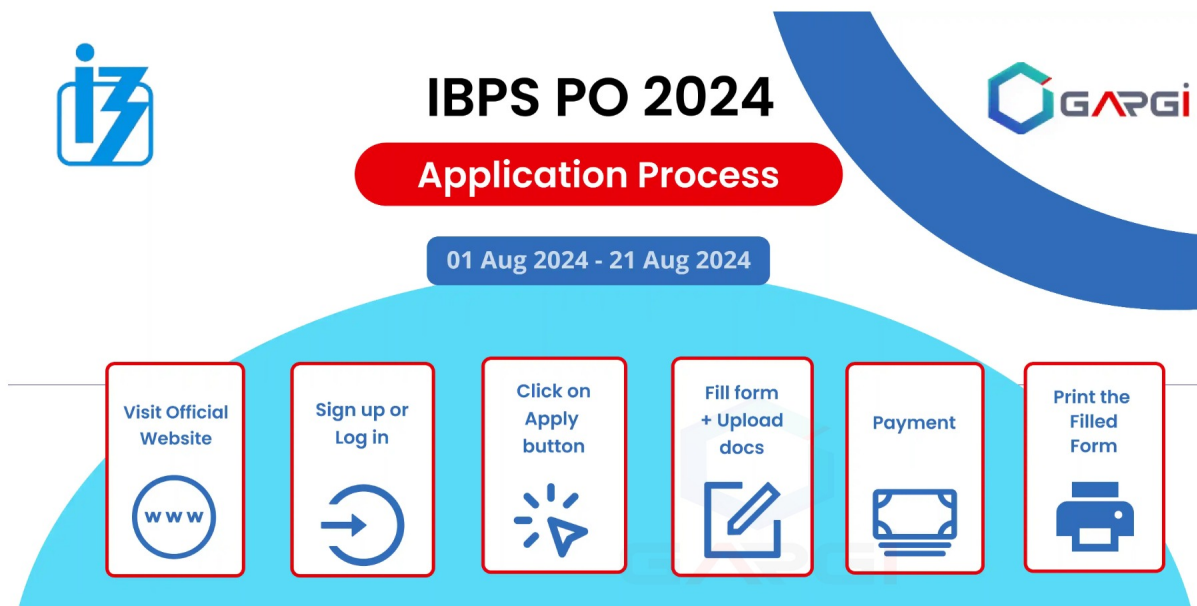

As per the [IBPS Calendar](#) released on January 15, 2024, the IBPS PO preliminary exams are scheduled for October 19 and 20, 2024. Admit cards for these exams are expected to be issued in the first or second week of October. The main exam is slated for November 30, 2024, approximately one month after the prelims, with admit cards for the main exam likely to be released by the end of October 2024.

- **Upload Documents:** Upload scanned copies of your photograph, signature, and handwritten declaration as per the required specifications.

The application fees or intimation charges for the IBPS PO exam, which can be paid online between August 1, 2024, and August 21, 2024 (both dates inclusive), are as follows: Rs. 175/- (including GST) for SC/ST/PwBD candidates, and Rs. 850/- (including GST) for all other candidates. Please note that any bank transaction charges for the online payment will be your responsibility.

Preliminary Exam:

- The IBPS PO preliminary exam includes 100 multiple-choice questions.
- The exam carries a total of 100 marks.
- Each correct answer awards 1 mark, but a penalty of 1/4 mark is deducted for every incorrect answer.
- The exam duration is 60 minutes.

Mains Exam:

- The main examination comprises 155 questions, with a total score of 200 marks.
- A penalty of 1/4 mark will be deducted for each incorrect answer.
- The examination lasts for 180 minutes.
- Additionally, along with the 155 objective-type questions, there will be 2 descriptive questions in the English Language (Letter Writing and Essay) worth 25 marks, which you will need to complete within 30 minutes.
- You must qualify in the preliminary examination to be eligible for the main examination.
