IBPS RRB Clerk Exam 2024 - Part I


The first stage of the IBPS RRB Clerk Exam 2024 is the preliminary round of the exam. The Exam Pattern for the preliminary exam is as follows:

- The exam is computer-based.
- · You will have 45 minutes to complete it.
- It consists of two subjects, each with 40 questions.
- There will be a negative marking of 1/4 of the assigned mark for each wrong answer.

IBPS RRB Clerk Exam 2024 - Document Verification

For the IBPS RRB Clerk Exam 2024 Document Verification, candidates must bring:

- Printout of the valid Interview Call Letter.
- Valid system-generated printout of the online application form for CRP RRBs-XII.
- Proof of Date of Birth: Birth Certificate or SSLC/Std. X Certificate with DOB.
- Photo Identity Proof: As specified in the advertisement.
- Mark Sheets or Certificates: For Graduation or equivalent qualification.
- Experience Certificates: If applicable, as of 21.06.2023 (Hardcopy/Digitally signed/Received from a valid email ID).
- Caste Certificate: For SC/ST/OBC candidates; OBC candidates must not be from the creamy layer and must not have their caste in the Central List.
- Income and Asset Certificate: For EWS category candidates, issued by authorized authorities.
- Disability Certificate: For Persons with Benchmark Disability, issued by the District Medical Board.
- · Scribe Details: If applicable, as per RPwD Act, 2016.
- For Ex-Servicemen: Copy of Service/Discharge Book and proof of rank held.
- For Current Defense Personnel: Certificate stating relief from defense services by 20.06.2024.

IBPS RRB Clerk 2024 Eligibility Criteria

Understanding your eligibility is a crucial first step in your exam preparation. To ensure you're on the right track, it's important to review the eligibility criteria outlined in the IBPS RRB Clerk Notification 2024. Nationality:

To be eligible for the IBPS RRB Clerk exam 2024, you must fit into one of these categories:

- · Be a citizen of India.
- Be a subject of Nepal or Bhutan.
- Be a Tibetan refugee who arrived in India before January 1, 1962, intending to settle permanently.
- Be a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, or certain East African countries (Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, Vietnam) with the intention of permanently settling in India.

If you belong to any of the last four categories, you must have a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India.

Age Limit:

Next, it's important to know the age requirements for the IBPS RRB Clerk Exam 2024.

• You need to be between 18 and 28 years old as of 01.06.2024 to be eligible.

Educational Qualification:

To be eligible for the IBPS RRB Clerk Exam 2024, you must have the following as of 27.06.2024:

- Hold a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or its equivalent.
- Be proficient in the local language as prescribed by the participating RRBs.
- Have basic working knowledge of computers.
