Age Limit (As on 01.06.2024)

• You must be between 18 and 28 years old.

Educational Qualification (As on 27.06.2024)

Thirdly, regarding educational qualifications:


- You must have a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or its equivalent.


