You need to ensure you meet the nationality requirements, fall within the specified age limits, and hold specified degrees. Remember that there are different eligibility criteria for different different posts as has been mentioned in the IBPS RRB Notification 2024. - · A citizen of India,
- a subject of Nepal or,
- a subject of Bhutan or,
- · a Tibetan Refugee,.....

Let's understand the above shown information in more detail with some pointers provided below:

Nationality

Firstly, to be eligible for the IBPS RRB Exam 2024, a candidate must fall under one of the following categories:

- · a Citizen of India or
- · a subject of Nepal or
- · a subject of Bhutan or
- a Tibetan Refugee who came over to India before January 1, 1962, to permanently settle in India.
- a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam intending to permanently settle in India.

Remember that if you belong to any of the last four categories, then you must have a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India.

Age Limit (As on 01.06.2024)

Secondly, the age criteria for the IBPS RRB Exam 2024 as per the IBPS RRB Notification 2024 are as follows:







- 1. For Office Assistant: You must fall between the ages of 18 to 28 years.
- 2. **For Officer Scale I (Assistant Manager):** You should be above 18 years and below 30 years and should not have been born earlier than 03.06.1994 and later than 31.05.2006 (both dates inclusive).
- 3. **For Officer Scale II (Manager):** You should be above 21 years and below 32 years and should not have been born earlier than 03.06.1992 and later than 31.05.2003 (both dates inclusive).
- 4. **For Officer Scale III (Senior Manager):** You should be above 21 years and below 40 years and should not have been born earlier than 03.06.1984 and later than 31.05.2003 (both dates inclusive).

Educational Qualification (As on 27.06.2024)

Lastly, the educational qualification for IBPS RRB Exam 2024 is as follows:

- Office Assistant: You must complete a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or possess an equivalent qualification.
- Officer Scale I (Assistant Manager): You must hold a bachelor's degree in any field.
- Officer Scale II General Banking Officer (Manager): A Bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized University or its equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate is required.
- · Officer Scale II Specialist Officers (Manager):
 - For Information Technology Officer post, you must hold a degree in any field with a minimum of 50% in Electronics, Communication, Computer Science, Information Technology, Law etc.
 - For Chartered Accountant post, you are required to have a Certified Associate (CA) from the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.
 - For Law Officer post, you are required to have a degree from a recognised University in Law or its equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate.
 - **For Marketing Officer post**, a Chartered Accountant or MBA in Finance from a recognized university/institution is required.
 - For Agricultural Officer post, a bachelor's degree in Agriculture/ Horticulture/ Dairy/ Animal Husbandry/ Forestry/ Veterinary Science/ Agricultural Engineering/ Pisciculture from a recognized university or its equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate is necessary.
- Officer Scale III (Senior Manager): You must hold a degree in any field with a minimum grade point average of 50%.





- · Head over to the official IBPS website at www.ibps.in.
- Navigate to the Home Page and find the "CRP for RRBs" link.
- Click on "APPLY ONLINE FOR CRP- RRBs-OFFICE-ASSISTANT" or "CLICK HERE TO APPLY ONLINE FOR CRP-RRBs-OFFICERS" to access the application form for the Office Assistant or Officer Scale position.
- Select "NEW REGISTRATION" and provide your basic information. After completing this step, you will receive a registration number and password from the system.
- · Carefully fill in all required details and upload the necessary documents in the correct format.
- If an application fee applies to you, make sure to complete the payment and submit your application.
- Don't forget to print out your application form for your records.





- The exam for Officer Scale I will be conducted in two tiers, i.e., prelims followed by mains. However, for the officer scales II and III, the exam will be conducted at a single level only.
- Additionally, candidates who have been shortlisted in the main examination for the post of Officers Scale I and in the single-level examination for the posts of Officers Scale II and III will then be called for an interview to determine their final selection.
- Lastly, the exam will be held online and will consist of objective-type questions.

IBPS RRB Clerk exam consists of two exams, one is a preliminary examination and the other is the main examination.

Preliminary Examination

- · This exam is computer-based.
- You'll have 45 minutes for completion.
- It comprises two subjects, each containing 40 questions.

Main Examination

- This is a computer-based examination.
- The exam comprises five subjects, each containing 40 questions.
- The main examination has a total of 200 marks, with one mark allocated for each of the 200 questions.
- Each candidate will be allotted a time limit of 2 hours for the exam.

IBPS RRB 2024 Syllabus

The mains exam, however, includes five subjects, which are:

- General Awareness
- English or Hindi
- · Quantitative Aptitude
