

- 5. Caste Certificate: For candidates applying under reserved categories, a valid caste certificate may be required.



## **Nationality:**

To be eligible for the RBI Assistant Exam 2024, a candidate must be:

- · An Indian citizen, or
- · A subject of Nepal, or
- · A subject of Bhutan, or
- · A Tibetan refugee who came to India before January 1, 1962, intending to permanently settle here, or
- A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, or any of the East African countries like Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, or Vietnam, intending to permanently settle in India.

Candidates in categories 2, 3, 4, and 5 must have a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India. While candidates requiring this certificate can take the exam, any offer of appointment will only be made once the eligibility certificate is issued by the Government of India.

### **Age Limit:**

The age limits for the RBI Assistant Exam 2024, based on last year's notification, are as follows:

Minimum Age: 20 YearsMaximum Age: 28 Years





### **Educational Qualifications:**

To apply for the RBI Assistant Exam 2024, candidates must meet the following educational qualifications and language requirements:

- 1. **Educational Qualifications:** Candidates should hold a Graduation Degree from a recognized university or its equivalent.
- 2. **Language Proficiency:** Applicants must be fluent in the language spoken in the state of the recruiting office or any of the states under that office's jurisdiction. Proficiency means being able to read, write, speak, and understand the language.
- 3. **Ex-Servicemen Category:** Candidates from the Ex-servicemen category (excluding dependents) should either be graduates from a recognized university or have passed the matriculation or an equivalent exam of the Armed Forces, with at least 15 years of defense service.
