RBI Grade B Exam 2024 - Phase I

The Phase I exam of the RBI Grade B is a single paper worth 200 marks, consisting of four sections: General Awareness, English Language, Quantitative Aptitude, and Reasoning. It features 200 questions to be completed in 120 minutes. The exam paper is available in Hindi and English (except for the English Language section), and scores are normalized using the equi-percentile method. Candidates must meet the minimum marks requirement for each section and overall to qualify, with a penalty of 1/4th of the marks for each incorrect answer. Successful candidates move on to Phase II.

- 120 minutes duration; available in Hindi and English.
- · Scores are normalized; minimum marks required for qualification.
- 1/4th mark penalty for wrong answers.
- Qualified candidates proceed to Phase II.

RBI Grade B Exam 2024 - Phase II


Phase II of the RBI Grade B exam is conducted for candidates shortlisted from Phase I, with exams held in multiple shifts. Candidates must appear for all shifts. The exam consists of three papers: Paper I and III, which include both objective and descriptive questions, and Paper II, which is entirely descriptive.

- Paper I and III last 120 minutes each (30 minutes for objective, 90 minutes for descriptive), while Paper II lasts 90 minutes.
- All papers, except the English Language, are available in English and Hindi. Descriptive answers must be typed using a keyboard.
- The total marks for Phase II are 300, with each paper worth 100 marks.
- Paper I and III's objective sections have 30 questions, some worth two marks and others one mark. The descriptive sections have six questions, with candidates required to answer four (two worth 15 marks, two worth 10 marks). If more than four questions are answered, only the first four are evaluated.
- Paper II consists of three descriptive questions.

Nationality:

The Nationality criteria required for the RBI Grade B Exam 2024 are as follows:

- · The candidate must be a citizen of India.
- · Alternatively, the candidate can be a subject of Nepal or Bhutan.
- The candidate can also be a Tibetan refugee who arrived in India before January 1, 1962.
- Additionally, the candidate may be a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, or Vietnam to permanently settle in India.

Educational Qualifications:

The minimum educational qualifications to apply for RBI Grade B Exam 2024 are:

- Graduation in any discipline or equivalent technical/professional qualification with at least 60% marks for General candidates and 50% for SC/ST/PwBD candidates.
- Post-graduation or equivalent technical qualification with at least 55% marks for General candidates and pass marks for SC/ST/PwBD candidates.

Age Limit:

The Minimum and Maximum age criteria for the RBI Grade B Exam 2024 are:

• Minimum age: 21 years

• Maximum age: 30 years (as of July 1, 2024)


