#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Following are the Eligibility Criteria for RBI Grade B



- A citizen of India,
- · a subject of Nepal or,
- · a subject of Bhutan or,
- · a Tibetan Refugee,.....



Bachelor's Degree/ Master's Degree

\*Depending on the posts



Min Age 21 Years Max Age 30 Years

#### Nationality:

A candidate must be one of the following:

- · a citizen of India, or
- · a subject of Nepal, or
- · a subject of Bhutan, or
- a Tibetan refugee who arrived in India before January 1, 1962, with the intention of permanently settling in the country, or
- a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, or Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.

Keep in mind that if you fall into any of the last four categories, you must obtain a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India.

#### Age Limit (As on 01.07.2024):

Secondly, the age requirements for the RBI Grade B Exam 2024, according to the RBI Grade B Notification 2024, are as follows:

- Minimum age: 21 years
- · Maximum age: 30 years
- The candidate must have been born not earlier than July 02, 1994 and not later than July 01, 2003.







There are also age relaxation provisions according to government regulations for candidates from reserved categories. These relaxations are designed to ensure fairness and equal opportunity for all.

#### **Educational Qualification (As on 01.07.2024):**

Lastly, the educational qualification for RBI Grade B Exam 2024 is as follows:

#### • For Officer in Grade B (DR) - General:

- Graduation in any discipline or an equivalent technical or professional qualification with a minimum of 60% marks (50% for SC/ST/PwBD applicants), or
- Post-Graduation in any discipline or an equivalent technical or professional qualification with a minimum of 55% marks (pass marks for SC/ST/PwBD applicants) in aggregate across all semesters/years.

#### • For Officer in Grade B (DR) - DSIM:

- A Master's Degree in Economics (or any related master's degree where "Economics" is the main focus of the curriculum, such as MA/MSc in Quantitative Economics, Mathematical Economics, Financial Economics, Business Economics, Agricultural Economics, Industrial Economics).
- A Master's Degree in Finance (or any related master's degree where "Finance" is the primary subject of the curriculum, such as MA/MSc in Quantitative Finance, Mathematical Finance, Quantitative Techniques, International Finance, Business Finance, Banking and Trade Finance, International and Trade Finance, Project and Infrastructure Finance, Agri Business Finance).
- A minimum of 55% marks or an equivalent grade is required in aggregate across all semesters/years from a recognized Indian or Foreign University/Institute.

#### • For Officer in Grade B (DR) - DEPR:

- A Master's Degree in Statistics/Mathematical Statistics/Mathematical Economics/Econometrics/Statistics
  & Informatics/Applied Statistics & Informatics with a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate across all semesters/years; OR
- A Master's Degree in Mathematics with a minimum of 55% marks or an equivalent grade in aggregate across all semesters/years, along with a one-year postgraduate diploma in Statistics or related subjects from a reputed institute; OR
- A Master's Degree in Data Science/Artificial Intelligence/Machine Learning/Big Data Analytics with a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate across all semesters/years from a recognized University/Institute, an institute of national importance, or a UGC/AICTE approved program; OR
- A Four-year Bachelor's Degree with a minimum of 60% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate across all semesters/years in Data Science/AI/ML/Big Data Analytics from a recognized University/Institute, an institute of national importance, or a UGC/AICTE approved program; OR
- A Two-year Post Graduate Diploma in Business Analytics (PGDBA) with a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate across all semesters/years from a recognized University/Institute, an institute of national importance, or a UGC/AICTE approved program.








Let's talk about the application fees for the RBI Grade B exam. Knowing the exact fee details is crucial, so here's a breakdown of the costs you need to be aware of:

- For SC, ST, and PWD Candidates: Good news! Your fee is significantly reduced to Rs. 100/- plus 18% GST.
- For RBI Staff: There's no application fee for RBI Staff.

#### **Preliminary Examination**

The preliminary examination will consist of a single objective-type paper worth 200 marks, with a duration of 120 minutes. The exam will cover four subjects:

- General Awareness
- Quantitative Aptitude
- English Language
- Reasoning

#### **Main Examination**







Thereafter, the mainscomprises of three papers carrying 100 marks each:

- 1. Paper I: Economics and Social Issues
  - Type: 50% Objective, 50% Descriptive (typed)
  - Marks: 100 (50 for objective, 50 for descriptive)
  - **Duration**: 120 minutes (30 minutes for objective, 90 minutes for descriptive)
- 2. Paper II: English (Writing Skills)
  - **Type**: Descriptive (3 questions)
  - ∘ **Marks**: 100
  - · Duration: 90 minutes
- 3. Paper III: Finance and Management
  - **Type**: 50% Objective, 50% Descriptive (typed)
  - Marks: 100 (50 for objective, 50 for descriptive)
  - **Duration**: 120 minutes
