



The IBPS Clerk exam consists of two stages: the Preliminary and Main Examinations. Both of these are online written tests. The exam is structured as follows:

IBPS Clerk Preliminary Examination:

The IBPS Clerk Prelims is an online exam that evaluates your aptitude, reasoning, and English skills. It consists of three sections, each with a 20-minute time limit. You need to clear the cutoff for each section to move on to the Mains examination. The total marks for the Prelims are 100, and the passing marks vary each year depending on the exam's difficulty level, as determined by IBPS.

You must achieve the minimum cut-off marks set by IBPS in each of the three sections. IBPS will determine the number of candidates to be shortlisted in each category for the Online Main Examination based on their specific requirements.

IBPS Clerk Mains Examination:

The IBPS Clerk Mains Exam now features 190 questions to be completed in 160 minutes. The Computer Aptitude and Reasoning Ability sections are combined, with 50 questions to be answered in 45 minutes. Both the Preliminary and Mains exams will be available in 13 regional languages, in addition to English and Hindi.
