



- A negative marking of 0.25 marks will be deducted for every wrong answer.
- The time duration of the preliminary examination is 60 minutes.

The IBPS Clerk mains exam shall have a total of 190 questions. You will be given a total of 160 minutes to finish the objective-based online test.

- There are a total number of 190 questions in the mains examination.
- The maximum marks for the examination is 200.
- A negative marking of 0.25 marks will be deducted for every wrong answer.
- The duration of the examination is 160 minutes.
- You need to qualify for the preliminary examination to attend the mains examination.
