





## **IBPS PO Topic Wise Weightage - Mains**

The IBPS PO mains examinations consist of 155 questions with a maximum mark of 200, and you get to attempt all the questions in 3 hours. It consists of two more questions, which are basically essay and letter writing. Basically, there are four sections that comprise mains paper. In addition to this, there are two more questions, as mentioned above, with a maximum mark of 25. The time you get to attempt them is 30 minutes. The list of important topics is provided below, followed by tables of each of these subjects with their respective weightages for your reference:
