The preliminary objective-based paper consists of three subjects, two of which are shared, namely Reasoning and English Language. For the Law Officer and Rajbhasha Adhikari, the third subject is General Awareness with special reference to the Banking Industry; for the IT Officer, Agriculture Field Officer, HR/Personnel Officer, and Marketing Officer, the third subject is Quantitative Aptitude. We have included the weightages for all the subjects that come under the IBPS SO syllabus 2024 for the preliminary exam below:

### English Language

Topics	Weightage
Reading Comprehension	10-15
Cloze Test	5-10
Sentence Correction	5-10

According to the table, reading comprehension carries more weight than the other topics listed.

### Reasoning

The table above shows that Puzzles/ Seating Arrangement holds more weightage.

## IBPS SO Syllabus 2024 - Mains Examination

The syllabus for the IBPS SO 2024 Mains varies by post. For Law Officer, IT Officer, Agriculture Field Officer, HR/Personnel Officer, and Marketing Officer, it includes a single test on Professional Knowledge. However, for the Rajbhasha Adhikari post, the main examination comprises both an objective and a descriptive test on Professional Knowledge.

- The total number of questions in the IBPS SO mains examination is 60 for the post of Law Officer, IT Officer, Agricultural Field Officer, HR/Personnel Officer and Marketing Officer.
- Whereas, the total number of questions in the IBPS SO mains examination is 47 for the post of Rajbhasha Adhikari.
- The maximum mark for the examination is 60.
- A negative mark of 1/4 of the assigned mark will be deducted for every wrong answer.
- The duration of the examination is 45 minutes for the post of Law Officer, IT Officer, Agricultural Field Officer, HR/Personnel Officer and Marketing Officer.
- Whereas, the duration of the examination is 60 minutes for the post of Rajbhasha Adhikari.
- Candidates need to qualify for the preliminary examination to attend the main examination.
