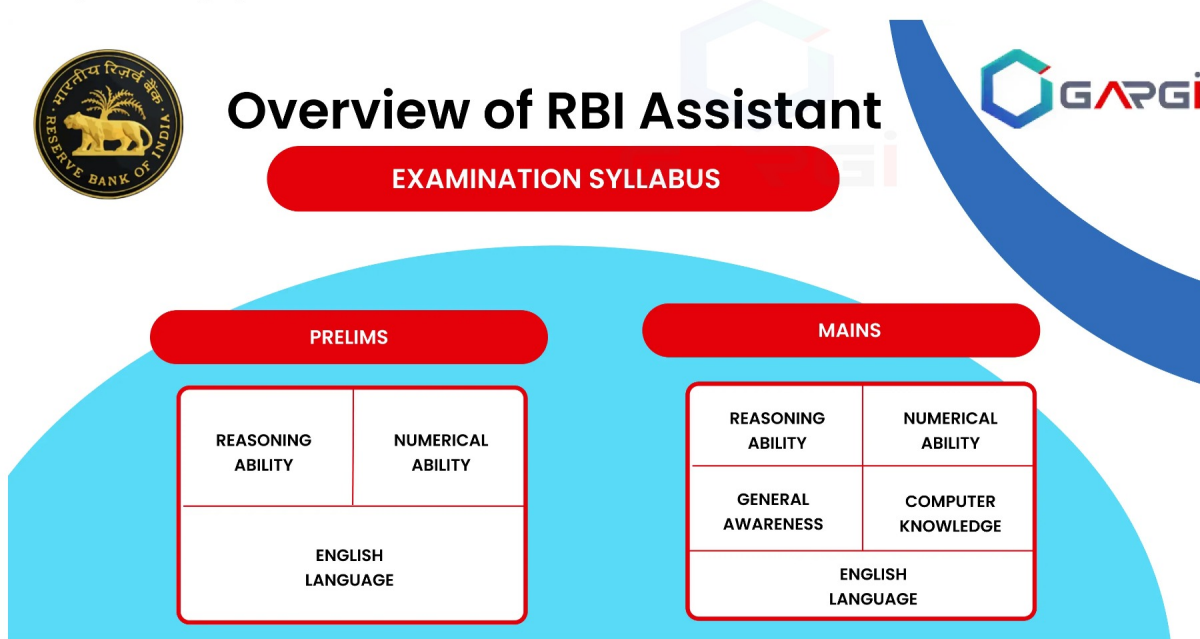

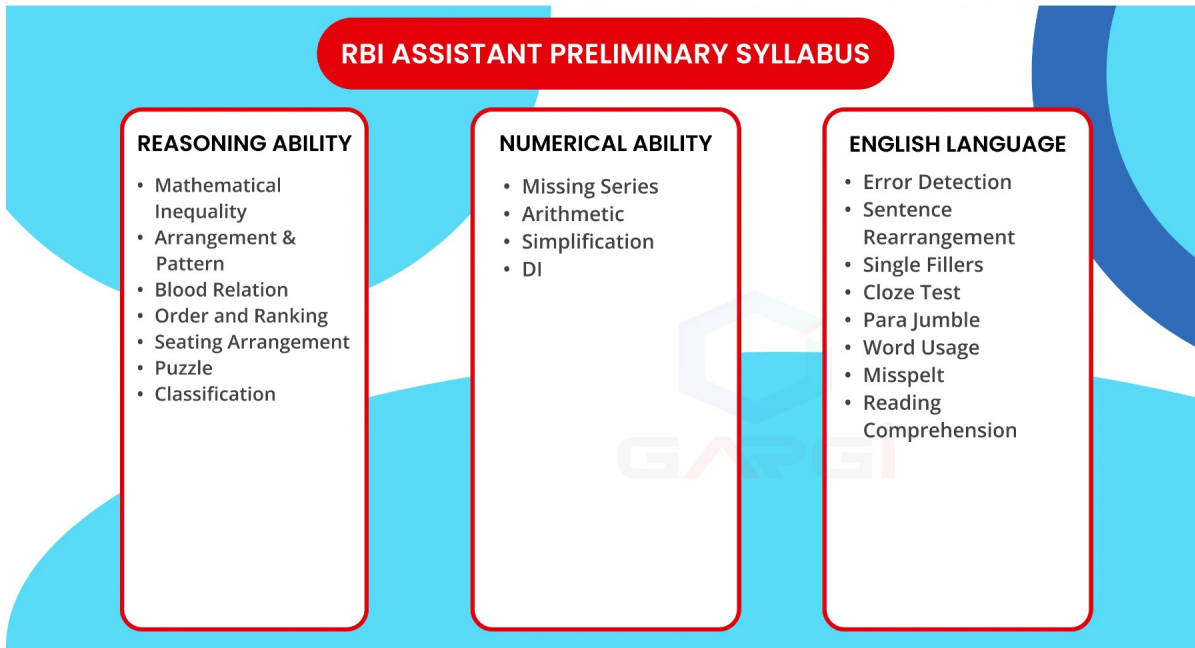

#### Preliminary Examination

The prelims exam consists of three sections totaling 100 marks. It is an objective-based online test with a duration of one hour. The sections are English Language, Numerical Ability, and Reasoning Ability.

- There are 100 questions in the RBI Assistant Exam.
- The maximum score for the preliminary exam is 100 marks.
- Each correct answer earns 1 mark.
- A penalty of 0.25 marks is applied for each incorrect answer.
- The exam duration is 60 minutes.

#### Main Examination

The IBPS Clerk mains exam will feature a total of 200 questions. You will have 135 minutes to complete this objective-based online test.

- The mains examination consists of 200 questions.
- The maximum score for the exam is 200 marks.
- There is a penalty of 0.25 marks for each incorrect answer.
- The exam duration is 160 minutes.
- You must pass the preliminary examination to be eligible for the mains exam.
