Analytical Reasoning Questions

Direction: Read the following information carefully and choose the right answer.

Question

Statement: Twenty individuals die each day on average after being hit by trains as they cross the railroad tracks at level crossings. Courses of action: I. The railway authority should be told to instruct all level crossings to be closed. II. People caught crossing the tracks after the gates have closed should face severe penalties.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 45 Seconds

Options:

- 1. Only I follows
- 2. Only II follows
- 3. Either I or II follows
- 4. Neither I nor II follows
- 5. Both I and II follow

Solution

The correct answer is Option 2 i.e. Only II follows

Given statement:

Twenty individuals die each day on average after being hit by trains as they cross the railroad tracks at level crossings.

Courses of action:

- I. The railway authority should be told to instruct all level crossings to be closed.
- II. People caught crossing the tracks after the gates have closed should face severe penalties.

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Explanation: By prohibiting passengers from crossing the tracks when the gates are closed, accidents can undoubtedly be avoided. Only II then follows.

Hence, the correct answer is **Only II follows.**



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
