### Question

Statement: Several regions of the country are reportedly experiencing a severe drought. The absence of rainfall during a drought results in severe water shortages. It might end fatally. Droughts develop gradually, in contrast to other extreme weather phenomena like earthquakes or hurricanes that occur more quickly. The Course of Action: I. The government should provide financial aid for individuals impacted right away. II. In order to save people and livestock, food, water, and fodder should be provided right away to all of these locations.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 62 Seconds

Options :

1. Only I follows
2. Only II follows
3. Both follows
4. Neither I nor II follows
5. Either I nor II follows

### Solution

The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **Only II follows**

**The course of action:**

I. The government should provide financial aid for individuals impacted right away.

II. In order to save people and livestock, food, water, and fodder should be provided right away to all of these locations.

**Explanation:** When a natural disaster strikes, the government's first responsibility is to provide the necessities needed to save both human and livestock lives. Thus, only the second conclusion is drawn.

Hence, the correct answer is **Only II follows.**
