Analytical Reasoning Questions Overview

Question

Direction: Read the given information carefully and answer the following questions. Statement: Pollution levels in Delhi deteriorated on Tuesday to the severe category with an air quality index (AQI) of 426, the highest so far this year. The city was set to record its worst air pollution levels since December 26, 2021, when the AQI was 459, amid an increase in farm fires and meteorological conditions favorable to the accumulation of pollutants. Which of the following is the most appropriate course of action for the above statement? I. The government should impose a ban on construction and demolition activities. II. All government employees should be given leave for a few days. III. Delhi government should increase the green cover and plant more trees.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 56 Seconds

- Options : 1. Only I is appropriate

 - 2. Only II and III are appropriate
 - 3. Only I and II are appropriate
 - 4. Only I and III are appropriate

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5. None of these

Solution

The correct answer is Option 4 i.e. Only I and III are appropriate

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Statements I and III are the only appropriate course of action to deal with the problem of air pollution in Delhi, whereas statement II is not appropriate as pollution is a permanent problem. The government cannot give leave to all employees, however, work from home for a few days, there may be a solution.

Hence the correct answer is Only I and III are appropriate.

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
