Question

Direction: Read the given information carefully and answer the following questions. Statement: At least 85 forest fires are raging in Uttarakhand, and have destroyed 165 acres of land in the past 24 to 48 hours, forcing the state to seek the Centre's intervention — two helicopters of the Indian Air Force were pressed into service Monday, and they flew several sorties to spray water over the fires — even as it became clear that the state, with a forest cover of 71% of its area, still does not have an effective strategy to deal with forest fires. Which of the following is the most appropriate course of action for stopping the forest fire? I. The only effective way to deal with forest fires is getting locals involved to ensure that: one, such fires are not man-made; and two, when fires start, enough people are mobilized to fight them. II. The government should impose a ban on the illegal cutting of trees and hunting of animals.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 67 Seconds

Options:

- 1. Only I is appropriate
- 2. Only II is appropriate
- 3. Both I and II are appropriate
- 4. Either I or II is appropriate
- 5. Neither I nor II is appropriate

Solution

The correct answer is Option 1 i.e. Only I is appropriate

Only statement I is the appropriate course of action while statement II makes no sense because forest fires do not stop by banning illegal logging and hunting. At the same time, the workforce increases with the involvement of local people and they are also aware about the forest.

Hence the correct answer is **Only I is appropriate.**

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
