Each consonant of the word 'TERMINATION' is changed to the previous letter in the English alphabetical series and each vowel is changed to the next letter in the English alphabetical series. If the new alphabets thus formed are arranged in alphabetical order (from left to right), which of the following will be the sixth letter from the right end?

Difficulty: Moderate Average Time: 41 Seconds

## Options:

## **Solution**

The correct answer is Option 1 i.e. M

Given word: T E R M I N A T I O N

Each consonant of the word is changed to the previous letter in the English alphabetical series and each vowel is changed to the next letter in the English alphabetical series.

SFQLJMBSJPM

Now, arranging in alphabetical order (from left to right)

BFJJLMMPQSS

M is sixth from the right.

Therefore the correct answer is M.

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
