Question

If all the letters of the word 'SINISTER' are changed in such a way that all the consonants and vowels are replaced with the immediately preceding and immediately succeeding letter of English alphabetical order respectively, then according to the English alphabetical order how many letters are there between the third letter from the right end and the fifth letter from the left end?

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 44 Seconds

Options :

1. One
2. Zero
3. Five
4. Fourteen
5. Seven

Solution

The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **Zero**

Given word: SINISTER

All the consonants and vowels are replaced with the immediately preceding and immediately succeeding letter of English alphabetical order respectively,

S	I	N	I	S	T	E	R
R	J	M	J	R	S	F	Q

In English alphabetical order, no letters are between the third letter from the right end (S) and the fifth letter from the left end (R).

Hence the correct answer is **Zero**.
