

Blood Relation Questions Overview

Blood Relation Questions

Direction: Read the given information carefully and answer the following questions. Eight persons sit around a circular table in such a way some are facing inside and some are facing outside the table. All persons are sitting at the same distance. S sits 1350 left of R. V sits 900 anti-clockwise direction of S. Q is not an immediate neighbour of S and V. U sits 1350 right of Q, who faces the opposite direction of R. W sits 900 left of P and both are facing the same direction. T is neither an immediate neighbour of P nor W. Immediate neighbours of T facing the same directions but opposite to T. W is not an immediate neighbour of S who is facing the same direction as V but opposite to W.

Question

Who among the following sits third to the right of R?

Difficulty: Moderate Average Time: 64 Seconds

Options:

- 1. P
- 2. S
- 3. U
- 4. V
- None of these

Solution

The correct answer is Option 4 i.e. V

- 1. S sits 135° left of R. (from this condition there are two possibilities)
- 2. V sits 90° anti-clockwise direction of S.

- 3. Q is not an immediate neighbour of S and V.
- $4. \ U \ sits \ 135^{o} \ right \ of \ Q, \ who \ faces \ the \ opposite \ direction \ of \ R. \ (from \ this \ condition \ there \ is \ one \ more \ possibility)$

There are three possibilities-


Case-1

- 5. W sits 90° left of P and both are facing the same direction. (From this condition case-3 will be eliminated)
- 6. T is neither an immediate neighbour of P nor W. (From this condition case-2 will be eliminated)
- 7. Immediate neighbours of T facing the same directions but opposite to T.



There is one more possibility in case 1 i.e. case 1a.







8. W is not an immediate neighbour of S who is facing the same direction as V but opposite to W.

From this condition, case 1a will be eliminated and the final arrangement is-A



From the above arrangement, V sits third to the right of R.

Hence, the correct answer is V.
