I is the father of T, who is the only brother of Z and Y. W is the daughter-in-law of K, who is the mother-in-law of U. Z is not married and X is his only nephew. B, who has only one sister, is the granddaughter of Y's mother. X is not W's son. T only has 2 children.

Question

How many siblings does X have?

Difficulty: Moderate

Average Time: 53 Seconds

Options:

- 1. 0
- 2. 1
- 3. 2
- 4. Either 1 or 2
- 5. None of these

Solution

The correct answer is Option 1 i.e. 0

I is the father of T, who is the only brother of Z and Y. T only has 2 children.

W is the daughter-in-law of K, who is the mother-in-law of U.

Z is not married and X is his only nephew.


B, who has only one sister, is the granddaughter of Y's mother.
