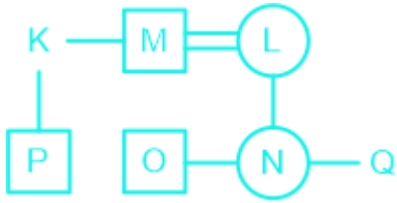

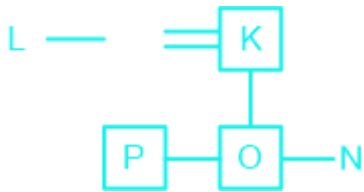
## Solution

The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **B**

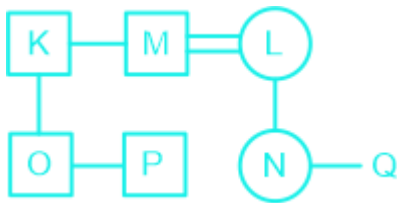
From statements I and II:
