Read the given information carefully and answer the following questions. Ten persons A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I and J are sitting in a row but not necessarily in the same order. Some of them are facing north while some of them are facing south. B sits third to the left of A. B sits at the left end of the row. G sits fourth right E. A and E are not immediate neighbours but facing the same direction. Two persons sit between C and H. F sits second to the left of C, who is facing north. F does not sit second from any ends. Immediate neighbours of A faces opposite direction. Immediate neighbour of E faces the same direction. The person sits at ends faces the same direction. Immediate neighbour of D faces the same direction, C and D faces the opposite direction. J sits second to the left of H, J is an immediate neighbour of I. More than three are facing north.

Question

Who is sitting third to the left of G?

Difficulty : Moderate

Options:

1. J

2. I

3. H

4. D

5. None of these



- 3) G sits fourth right E.
- 4) F sits second to the left of C, who is facing north.
- 5) Two persons sit between C and H.
- 6) J sits second to the left of H, J is an immediate neighbour of I.
- 7) A and E are not immediate neighbours but facing the same direction.
- 8) F does not sit second from any ends.
- 9) Immediate neighbours of A faces opposite direction.
- 10) Immediate neighbour of E faces the same direction.
- 11) The person sits at ends



Hence, I sits third to the left of G.
