Question

Which of the following codes stands for the word 'is'?

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 47 Seconds

Options :

1. tb

3. vi
4. Either (1) or (3)
5. None of these

Solution

The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **vi**

The boy has a toy → mn kp tb wa np
 The toy is soft → tb vi nl mn
 He has soft toy → tb kp nl gh

The codes for the following words are:

Words	Codes
The	mn
Toy	tb
Soft	nl
Has	kp
is	vi
He	gh

In the above table, we can see that the word 'is' has a code 'vi'.
