## Coding Decoding Questions

Direction: Read the given information carefully and answer the following questions. In a certain code language, "Due Insurance Premium Payable" is coded as "DR9 LK7 DK7 DW3" "Pay All Your Due Premium" is coded as "KZ3 QB4 DW3 LK7 XK3" "Own Family Life Insured" is coded as "XU6 ML3 CR7 DO4" "Family will Insured" is coded as "KD4 XU6 CR7"

### Question

What does "CR7 DW3 KZ3 XK3" represents in the same code language?

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 51 Seconds

Options :

1. Life all pay Insured
2. Premium pay all due
3. Insured pay and due
4. Due pay all insured
5. Cannot be determined

### Solution

The correct answer is **Option 4** i.e. **Due pay all insured**

**Coding Pattern:**

1st element of the code = The last letter of the word - 1

2nd element of the code = Reverse of the first letter of the word (when all letters are arranged in this way as shown in the diagram)

3rd element of the code = Number of letters in the word

Hence the correct answer is **Due pay all insured.**
