Coding Decoding Questions

Direction: Read the information carefully and answer the following questions. In English alphabetical series, the consonants are replaced by their actual positions (in number) and the vowels are replaced by letters immediately succeeding them.

Question

What does '6 18 F 19 8' mean in that code language?

Difficulty : Difficult

Average Time : 38 Seconds

Options :

1. FRESH
2. FLESH
3. TRASH
4. FRUIT
5. FLAME

Solution

The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **FRESH**

Understanding

Given code: 6 18 F 19 8

The logic used: The consonants are replaced by their actual positions, and the vowels are replaced by letters immediately succeeding them.

We have to write an immediate succeeding letter at the place of vowels and an actual position in number at the place of consonants.

In this way,

6 is code for F

18 is code for R

F is code for E (the immediate succeeding letter of E is F, that is used in code)

19 is code for S

8 is code for H

Thus, 6 18 F 19 8 means **FRESH**
