## Question

How many sisters does K have? Statement I: M is sister of K. Statement II: K's mother has three children.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 30 Seconds

Options :

1. If the data in statement I is sufficient to answer the question
2. If the data in statement II is sufficient to answer the question
3. If the data either in statement I or statement II is sufficient to answer the question
4. If the data in both statements I and II together are not sufficient to answer the question

## Solution

The correct answer is **Option 4** i.e. **If the data in both statements I and II together are not sufficient to answer the question**

### Understanding

From statement I it clears that K and M are siblings and M is female.

From statement II, we can conclude that K has two siblings.

But from both the statement, gender of K and the third child of K's mother is not clear.

Hence, **If the data in both statements I and II together are not sufficient to answer the question.**
