Choose your response accordingly among A, B, C, D and E. A) If the data in Statement I alone is sufficient to answer the question. B) If the data in Statement II alone is sufficient to answer the question. C) If the data either in Statement I alone or in Statement II alone is sufficient to answer the question. D) If the data in both the Statements I and II together are not sufficient to answer the question. E) If the data in both the Statements I and II together are necessary to answer the question.

Question

How is E related to U? Statement I: C and D are brothers of B and E is the son of D. Statement II: A is the mother of U who is the son of B.

Undersatnding Application

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






Statement I:

C and D are brothers of B and E is son of D.



No information about U is given. **Statement II:** A is mother of U who is son of B.



No information about E is given.

From I, we can determine that E is the nephew or niece of B

From II, we can determine that A is the wife of B.



From both statements, we concluded that E is the cousin of U.

Hence, the correct answer is E i.e. If the data in both the Statements I and II together are necessary to answer the question.

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
