M C Bhandari Committee

- The **Bhandari Committee** on the restructuring of regional rural banks (RRBs) was set up in **1994**.
- The Bhandari Committee identified 49 RRBs for comprehensive restructuring.
- A V Sardesai and Chalapathy Rao also headed the committee on RRBs. A V Sardesai Committee was constituted in 2005 whereas Chalapathy Rao Committee was constituted in 2003.

Regional Rural Banks (RRBs)

- The Narsimham Committee conceptualised the creation of RRBs in 1975.
- The RRBs were set up through the promulgation of the RRB Act, 1976.
- Five RRBs were inaugurated on 2 October 1975 with the first one being "Prathma Bank" sponsored by Syndicate Bank in Moradabad district in Uttar Pradesh.
- As per RRB Act, Centre, Sponsor Bank and State government share is in the ratio 50:35:15.
- As per RBI guidelines, RRBs have to provide 75% of their total credit under Priority Sector Lending.
- At present, there are 45 RRBs in the country.
