Question

Who among the following has the power to remove Election Commissioner from his office?

Difficulty: Moderate Average Time: 29 Seconds

Options:

- 1. The Governor
- 2. The Prime Minister
- 3. Attorney General
- 4. The President

Solution

The correct answer is **Option 4** i.e. **The President.**

- Election Commissioner can be removed from his office by the Parliament on the recommendation of the Chief Election Commissioner.
- The Chief Election Commissioner is removed from his office by Parliament with two-thirds majority in Lok sabha and Rajya sabha on the ground of proved misbehaviour and incapacity.
- Both Chief Election Commissioner and Election Commissioners are appointed by the President.
