Solution

• In response to the verdict on <u>State</u> of Madras v. Champakam Dorairajan case(1951), it made provision for special treatment of educationally and socially backward classes by adding the 9th schedule to the Constitution. It prevented the acts listed in the 9th Schedule from being subjected to judicial review.

• 9th Schedule was basically made for the property law which was introduced under article 31-B.

• The objective of ninth schedule was to save land reforms law enacted by various states from being challenged in the court to facilitate agrarian reforms of the government of India.
