- It was a landmark judgment of the supreme court of India where the Court discussed at length provisions of article 356 of the Indian constitution and related issues.
- This case had a huge impact on Centre-State Relations. The judgment attempted to curb blatant misuse of Article 356 of the Constitution of India, which allowed presidential rule to be imposed over state governments.
