• Section 1 under the Police Act of 1861 deals with "Interpretation Clause." It says that the following words or expressions in this Act shall having the meaning assigned to them, unless the subject of context is contradictory to such construction. For instance, the word "Magistrate of the District" will be referred to the chief officer who has been charged with the executive administration of a district. It shall also include all the persons coming within the general police district who are exercising all or of the powers of a magistrate.
