- All of the following classification of offences comes under the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
- **Cognizable** The code under Section 2 (clause c) defines "Cognizable Offence" as those cases where a police officer, for the time being, may arrest without warrant.
- **Non-cognizable-** The code under Section 2(I) states that the non-cognizable officer are those cases in which a police officer has no authority to arrest without a warrant.
- Bialable offences under Section 2 (a) means an offence which is shown as bialable, as given in the first schedule.
- **Non-bialable offences** under Section (a) are those non-bialable offence in which a person has no right to be released on bail but the bail can be granted at the judgement of the court.
